CARE FOR THE COURSE

Despite notices and repeated reminders, there are golfers who still fail, refuse and/or neglect to practice the most basic golfing etiquette of caring for the course such as repairing divots and ball marks, raking bunkers, avoiding slow play, no littering, driving the buggy in a safe manner etc.

It is COMPULSORY for all golfers or his/her caddy to bring along the sand bottle for any shot to be made on the General Areas of the Course, irrespective of whether you make divots or not during your stroke.

The Management Committee has given the green light to the Course Marshalls to video record or take photographs of any offenders for further action by the Disciplinary Committee.





CHANGING ROOM

Members are now allowed to shower in the Changing Room but towels and toiletries are NOT provided.



NO SMOKING

As from 1st January 2019, it is illegal to smoke in all restaurants and eateries in Malaysia under Regulation 11(1)(d) of the Control of Tobacco Product Regulations 2004.

However, there have been members spotted smoking at the cafeteria. All members are therefore reminded NOT to smoke inside the Club's Cafeteria and Administration Office.
