HEALTH & SAFETY ON THE COURSE

We wish to advise members not to exert themselves if they feel tired or unwell. Recently, a member collapsed while walking towards his trolley and hit his forehead on the buggy path. He bled profusely and was brought to the hospital by our staff for treatment and required 9 stitches to sew the wound close. Fortunately, there was no internal bleeding. If you feel tired or unwell, please stop playing.

On the issue of safety on the course, we wish to advise members to drive the buggy with care. Recently too, a member drove the buggy into a bunker. In another incident, 2 buggies collided as one member drove too fast around the blind and sharp corner and crossed over to the other member's lane. Please drive the buggy slowly while going downhill or around turns.

Other Safety Precautions

- Do not hang your feet, legs, arms or hands out of the buggy while it's in motion.
- If there is lightning or there is a blast of siren, stop play immediately and head for the clubhouse or shelter. Stay away from trees and do not stay in the buggy.
- Yell "Fore!" or "Ball!" if you hit your ball in the direction of other golfers.
